

Urban Forest Funding Packages



This collaboration between Kura Tāwhiti Canterbury Community Foundation (KTCCF) and Christchurch City Council (CCC) seeks to improve food resilience and increase overhead canopy by planting and cultivating fruit trees in public green spaces.

There are **four funding package options** to cover the purchase, planting and maintenance of new and existing trees. Please note that each donation includes a small fee for administration, and a contribution to the Green Philanthropy Fund - an endowment fund supporting environmental progress in our region.

Option 1.

- ✓ Purchase of 5 trees plus 5 years of maintenance and fruit collection
- ✓ Supports future sustainability projects through the Green Philanthropy Fund

\$6,000

Option 2.

- ✓ Purchase of 10 trees plus 5 years of maintenance and fruit collection
- ✓ Supports future sustainability projects through the Green Philanthropy Fund
- ✓ CCC acknowledgment in *Newsline* and option to visit park with CCC representative after planting
